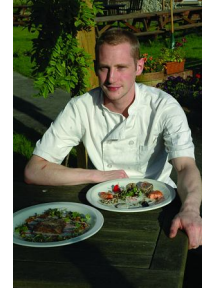




Chef Tasting Menu Dinner

Tio Pepe, Manzanilla Sherry
Uncompromisingly dry, made with palomino grapes from the 'Jerez Superior' region
IWC multiple gold and silver medal winner

Rosé, Forrest Estate, Marlborough (New Zealand)
2008 13.5%
Vibrant colour and flavours in this appetising pink – juicy red fruitiness and a hint of sweetness.

Pinotage, Seidelberg Estate, Paarl (South Africa)
2007 15%
South Africa's 'native' grape produces here an exotic, robust red with an almost sweet fruitiness

Samos, Vin Doux, Union de Samos (Greece)
2005 15%
Muscat grape: rich, toffee & fresh peach flavours; dry honey finish. (Really, it is a nice Greek wine)
